RE: Non-Potable Water Update as of 06-11-2026

Hello,

We have good news on the water front. Thanks to a combination of higher-than-expected mountain snowpack, lighter agricultural demand upstream, and the additional water supplies the District secured earlier this season, we are in a much better position than anticipated.

Effective immediately, residential irrigation will resume **four days per week**. Your landscaping contractor will handle the scheduling. If you have questions about your specific irrigation days, contact your HOA manager or the District. Please note that irrigation schedules in WHMD are everchanging and not always consistent.

The District will also begin irrigating the common area tracts on a similar schedule, or as conditions allow.

Water availability in Colorado can change without much notice. We expect this schedule to hold ABOUT three weeks, then we will be back on watering restrictions. This may change, and we will communicate any adjustments promptly if conditions shift.

Thank you for your patience this season. We appreciate it.
